



**Statutory Notice: RCO 7**

## **PARISH WALK NOTICE 2024**

The Department of Infrastructure makes this Notice under section 38 of the Highways Act 1986.

### **1 Title**

This Notice is the Parish Walk Notice 2024.

### **2 Commencement and expiry**

This Notice comes into operation on 22 June 2024 and expires on 23 June 2024.

### **3 Roads closed to motor vehicles**

The roads specified in columns 1 and 2 of the table in Schedule 1 are closed to motor vehicles on the date and during the period specified in columns 3 and 4 of that table.

### **4 Imposition of one way traffic**

The roads specified in columns 1 and 2 of the table in Schedule 2 are subject to a one-way restriction on the date and during the period specified in columns 3 and 4 and a person must not cause or permit a vehicle to travel otherwise than in the direction specified in column 5 of that table.

### **5 Temporary speed limit**

The roads specified in column 1 of the table in Schedule 3 are subject to a temporary speed limit and a person must not cause or permit a vehicle to travel in excess of the speed specified in column 3 (30 mph) during the period specified in column 2 of that table.

### **6 Prohibition of parking**

Parking is prohibited on the roads specified in column 1 of the table in Schedule 4 on the date and during the period specified in columns 2 and 3 of that table.

### **7 Exemptions**

(1) This Notice shall not apply to emergency service vehicles.



- (2) Paragraphs 3, 4 and 6 shall not apply to any vehicles authorised by the organiser or a police officer in uniform.

## **8 Appointment of Marshals**

- (1) The organiser must appoint marshals<sup>1</sup> in respect of any race to be held pursuant to this Notice.
- (2) In relation to the appointment of marshals, the organiser must comply with section 9 of the Road Races Act 2016.

## **9 Cancellation etc.**

- (1) If the organiser is given a change notice<sup>2</sup> —
  - (a) where the notice suspends or revokes this Notice; or
  - (b) where the notice varies this Notice and the Department directs the organiser to do so,the organiser must stop, cancel, suspend or postpone the event or any part of the event specified in the notice.
- (2) In any case to which sub-paragraph (1) applies, the organiser must notify the senior police officer<sup>3</sup> and take such measures as the organiser considers appropriate to inform the public of the effect of it.

## **10 Notification of end of temporary restriction**

At the end of each period that a traffic restriction is in force, the organiser must make such provisions as seem expedient for giving official notification to the public of the conclusion of the event or any part of the event.

## **11 Erection and removal of barriers and signs**

- (1) The organiser must ensure that it has sufficient signage in order to be able to comply with this Notice and provide a copy of its plans regarding signage to the Department not less than 12 weeks prior to the start of any road traffic restriction or such shorter period as the Department may specify.
- (2) The organiser must ensure that signage is erected and maintained immediately before, or as soon as possible after, the beginning of every restricted period, and in any event before the relevant part of the course is used for the event.

<sup>2</sup> A change notice may be issued by the Department under section 8 of the Road Races Act 2016.

<sup>3</sup> Senior police officer means a person authorised by the Chief Constable to act as such for the purposes of this Notice.



- (3) The organiser must ensure that the signage referred to in sub-paragraphs (1) and (2) –
- (a) is erected and maintained in accordance with the plans provided to the Department under sub-paragraph (1); and
  - (b) is clearly visible to approaching traffic.
- (4) The organiser must ensure that the signage referred to in this paragraph is removed at the end of every restricted period.

## 12 Insurance

The organiser (Manx Harriers Athletics Club) must secure insurances and indemnities against death, injury or damage to persons or damage to property arising out of the conduct of the event or arrangements incidental to them of at least two million pounds (£2,000,000).
